# 1. General

## 1.1. Organizer

- 1.1.1. The 10<sup>th</sup> FAI European Advanced Aerobatic Championship 2017 (EAAC) will take place under the auspices of the Czech National Aeroclub.
- 1.1.2. The local Organizer is Aeroklub Chotěboř, Airfield Chotěboř, Czech Republic.

## 1.2. Place and Date

- 1.2.1. The event will take place at Chotěboř Airfield (LKCT), located about 120 km south-east of Prague, the capital of the Czech Republic.
- 1.2.2. More info about airfield is available at [www.eaac2017.eu](http://www.eaac2017.eu).
- 1.2.3. The event will take place in the period of time: **August 5<sup>th</sup> to August 13<sup>th</sup> 2017.**

## 1.3. Official Training Flights

- 1.3.1. Official training flights at LKCT airfield will be possible from July 31<sup>th</sup> till August 4<sup>th</sup> 2017. The competition box will be marked during official training days.

- 1.3.3. Training at other airfields in LKCT vicinity is possible with previous agreement of the Organizer. In case of need, please contact the Organizer at e-mail: [info@eaac2017.eu](mailto:info@eaac2017.eu) or the other contact information in part 10 of this document.
- 1.3.4. Booking of slots for official training days will be available at the official contest website [www.eaac2017.eu](http://www.eaac2017.eu).

## 1.4. Schedule

- 1.4.1. Official working hours of the Contest Office and the Organizer will be from 08.00LT to half an hour after the landing of the last competitor or 20.00LT whatever comes later.
- 1.4.2. These hours are valid for any official inquiries or information or deposit of claims/protest concerning the contest during the contest's period.
- 1.4.3. All times are stated in local time (LT=UTC+2 hrs).
- 1.4.4. The Schedule may be changed due to technical and organizational reasons as well as the weather conditions.

## **2. Regulations**

### **2.1. Rules**

2.1.1. The EAAC2017 will be conducted according to the following rules:

- FAI Sporting Code – General Section,
- FAI Sporting Code – Section 6 Part 1,
- Flight Rules published by the Civil Aviation Authorities of the Czech Republic,
- Local Regulations.

## **3. Participation, Competitors and Aircrafts**

### **3.1. Participants**

3.1.1. All FAI member NACs may be represented at the EAAC2017 by the team and/or an individual competitors/observers.

3.1.2. Entries will be accepted from National Aero Clubs only (according to FAI Sporting Code, Section 6 Part 1).

3.1.3. Other non-NAC entries will be accepted according to FAI Sporting Code, Section 6 Part 1.

3.1.4. Each competitor has to be a holder of:

- a valid Pilot License with an aerobatic extension according to competitors national legislation,
- a valid FAI Sporting License,
- a valid Medical certificate.

### **3.2. Aircraft**

3.2.1. All participating aircraft must satisfy the performance criteria essential for competition flights in the advanced/unlimited aerobatic category.

3.2.2. For all competing aircraft a valid Certificate of Airworthiness of the related country must be presented.

3.2.3. For all competing aircraft using the airspace of the Czech Republic, liability insurance must be concluded with respect to damage caused by operation of that aircraft to third parties covering a minimum amount in SDR (Special Drawing Rights) or in equivalent value of any other freely convertible currencies, for the aircraft with MTOW as mentioned below:

- MTOW up to 1000 kg                      1.500.000 SDR (approx. 1.800.000 EUR)
- MTOW above 1000 kg to 2700 kg        3.000.000 SDR (approx. 3.600.000 EUR)

3.2.4. Each competing aircraft must be insured against 3rd Party Public Liability, according to EU Regulation (EC) No. 785/2004, claims with a minimum amount as mentioned above according to MTOW. Aircraft arriving to the Czech Republic must be able to present their insurance policy with a copy in English, certified by the Insurance Company.

- 3.2.5. Hangar space for competing aircraft will be available free of charge for the period of the Championship.
- 3.2.6. In case of insufficient hangar capacity, priority will be determined by the Organizer. In case of doubt, the order of received Entry Fee payment dates will be taken in account.

## **4. Team Composition**

### **4.1. Competitors**

- 4.1.1. As specified in para 3.1. of this Bulletin.

### **4.2. Other Team Members**

- 4.2.1. Each team may include team members according to FAI Sporting Code, Section 6 Part 1.

### **4.3. Observers**

- 4.3.1. Other persons (i.e. team member's relatives) will be accepted as observers of National Team with same conditions as Team members.

## **5. Entries and Registration**

### **5.1. Deadline for the Entries**

- 5.1.1. The Preliminary Entry Forms should be provided to the Organizer not later than **May 15<sup>th</sup> 2017**.
- 5.1.2. The Official Entry Forms as well as the Entry Fees must be provided to the Organizer not later than **June 28<sup>th</sup> 2017**.
- 5.1.3. If payment is made later or at the contest site, an additional **EUR 200** will be charged.
- 5.1.4. Any participant wishing to query the arrival and clearance of their fees should contact the Organizer using e-mail [info@eaac2017.eu](mailto:info@eaac2017.eu) or the other contact information in part 10 of this document.
- 5.1.5. Entry Fee must be paid in full amount and bank fees must be charged to sender's account.

### **5.2. Registration**

- 5.2.1. Registration can be made using following communication channels:
- Ordinary mail - send your applications to AEROKLUB CHOTĚBOŘ at the address specified in part 10.1.
  - Electronically using email – use email address [info@eaac2017.eu](mailto:info@eaac2017.eu) in which case registrations should be considered as valid after confirmation from the Organizer.
  - Electronically using the webform at website [www.eaac2017.eu](http://www.eaac2017.eu). In this case confirmation letter form NAC needs to be uploaded. More details available at contest website.

5.2.2. Registration is valid and complete by submitting the Official Entry Forms or online registration form with NAC confirmation by mail, e-mail or online.

### 5.3. **Free Known sequence submission**

5.3.1. **Deadline for the Free Known submission is on 2<sup>nd</sup> of August (WED) at 20.00 LT.**

5.3.2. Competitors may submit their Free Known sequence to the e-mail address [info@eaac2017.eu](mailto:info@eaac2017.eu). Every submission will be confirmed. Sequence submissions are not valid without confirmation.

5.3.3. Free Known sequences should be submitted using latest version of OpenAero or Microsoft Visio Aresti software file format.

## 6. **Entry Fees**

### 6.1. **Entry Fees**

6.1.1. Entry Fees are specified as follows:

- Competitor: **EUR 1700**
- Other team members and observers: **EUR 1450**

6.1.2. To pay the Entry Fee please use the bank details provided in the paragraph 11.1.1

6.1.3. The Entry Fee covers:

- Accommodation of the participant during the Championship
- 3 meals per day
- Official and social functions;
- Program arranged by the Organizer.
- The CIVA Sanction Fee, 160 EUR per pilot.

6.1.4. Single room will be charged by additional fee of **200 EUR**.

6.1.5. See para 5.1.3 for late payment fee.

### 6.2. **Entry Fee Refund Policy**

6.2.1. If a registered competitor or official has to withdraw, his/her NAC may substitute another pilot or official with no financial penalty. If a participant wishes to cancel their entry, the NAC representative must contact the Organizer. The date of withdrawal will be noted by the Organizer and will set the proportion of the fee to be refunded by the Organizer.

6.2.2. Withdrawal before 28<sup>th</sup> June 2017 – 100% of the entry fee will be refunded.

6.2.3. Withdrawal after 28<sup>th</sup> June and up to 30<sup>th</sup> July 2017 – 50% of the fee will be refunded.

6.2.4. Withdrawal after 30<sup>th</sup> July 2017 – no entry fee will be refunded.

6.2.5. In the case of entry fee refunds the refunded amount will be reduced by any bank fees that apply on the Organizer side.

6.2.6. If a competitor is disqualified from the event according to FAI Sporting Code, Section 6 part 1, no entry fee will be refunded.

## 7. Protests

### 7.1. Protest Fee

7.1.1. Protest must be submitted accompanied by the payment of 70 EUR.

## 8. Accommodation and catering

### 8.1. Accommodation

8.1.1. Accommodation for Competitors and other Team members will be covered by the Organizer from **August 5<sup>th</sup> to August 13<sup>th</sup>** (8 nights). Meals will be provided from **August 5<sup>th</sup> to August 13<sup>th</sup>** (8 days).

8.1.2. List of the hotels will be published on the contest website [www.eaac2017.eu](http://www.eaac2017.eu).

### 8.2. Catering

8.2.1. Three meals per day and refreshment for all participants will be arranged by the Organizer. Breakfast will be provided by hotel. Lunch and dinner will be provided in the area of the LKCT airfield.

8.2.2. Meals for Competitors and Team members will be provided from **August 5<sup>th</sup> (dinner) to August 13<sup>th</sup> 2017 (lunch)**.

8.2.3. Meals and refreshment will be available during official training days in local airport catering service.

## 9. Officials

9.1.1. No Entry Fee is required for CIVA appointed Officials.

9.1.2. Organizer covers accommodation and meals for following Officials:

- 3 members of International Jury.
- Chief Judge and 2 Assistants.
- 10 CIVA selected Judges.
- 10 CIVA selected Judge Assistants.

9.1.3. Accommodation for Officials will be covered by the Organizer from **August 4<sup>th</sup> to August 13<sup>th</sup>** (9 nights). Meals will be provided from **August 4<sup>th</sup> to August 13<sup>th</sup>** (9 days).

Accommodation of all Officials will be in double rooms arranged by the Organizer. The Organizer will try to fulfill any requests for specific accommodation needs, but additional costs (i.e. single room) will not be covered.

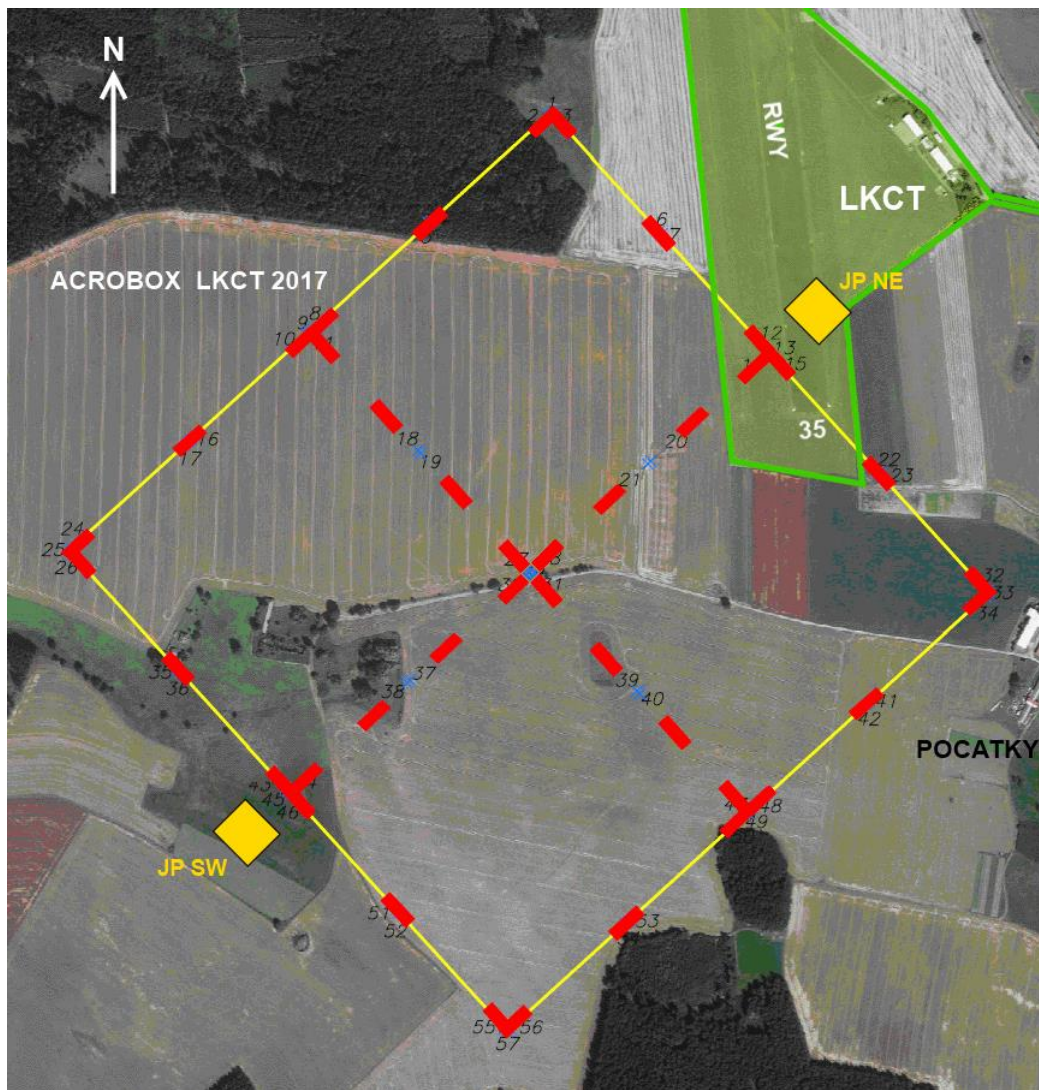
